Just before the stroke of half time, Mike Fearon scored his second try which was converted to make the score at the break 29 – 0.

The second half began as the first ended, Dom McGrath, now playing full-back, started a great line via Adam Robertson to allow Jamie Harrison a well deserved try. The floodgates had now opened, and tries followed from Jordie Clement, Mike Fearon, Alex Clark and debutant James Ord, leading, with conversions from Tom McMann and Mike Fearon to a score-line of 60 – 0 in favour of Carlisle.
